Three of those, “The Admiral” (2014), “Ode To My Father” (2014), and “Veteran” (2015), respectively, have also become the top three highest grossing films in Korean history.

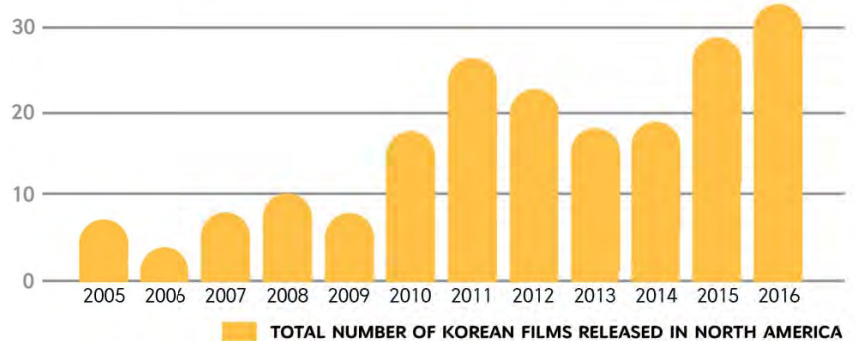

THEATRICAL DISTRIBUTION

Since 2005 to present, CJ Entertainment America has distributed a total of over 120 films across the US and Canada. The company releases 8 to 10 Korean films every year in approximately over 40 different cities including Los Angeles, San Francisco, Vancouver, Seattle, Las Vegas, New Jersey, D.C., and Toronto,



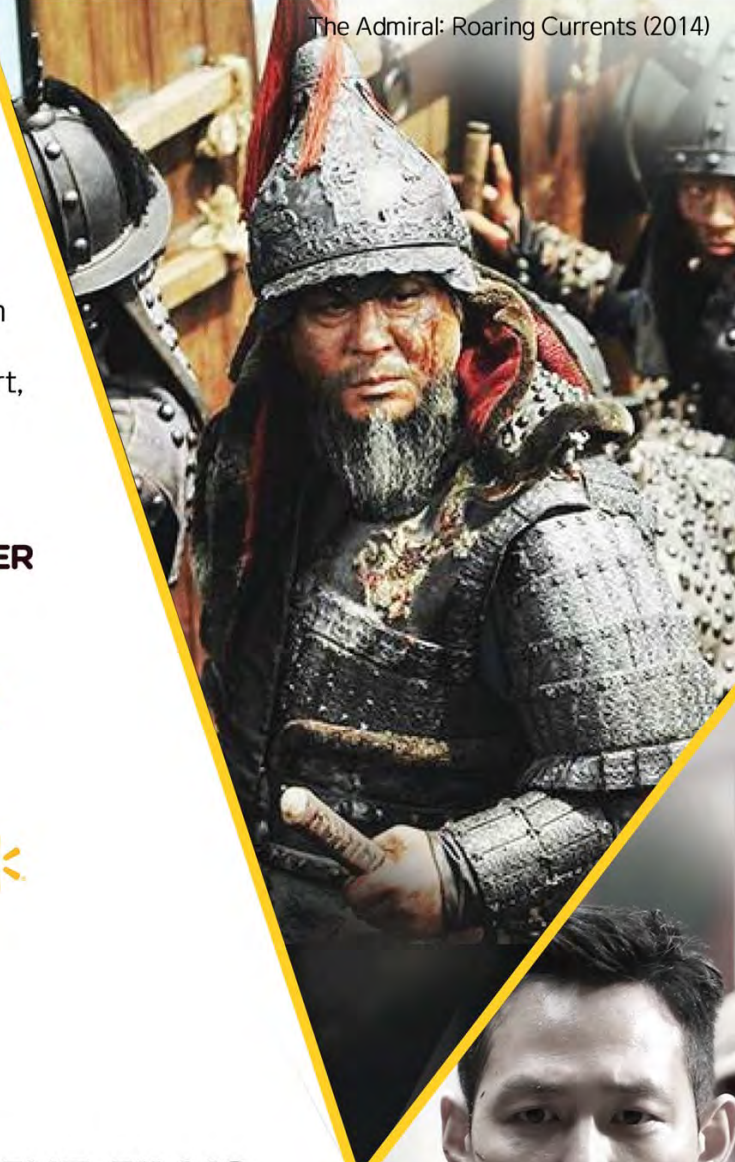

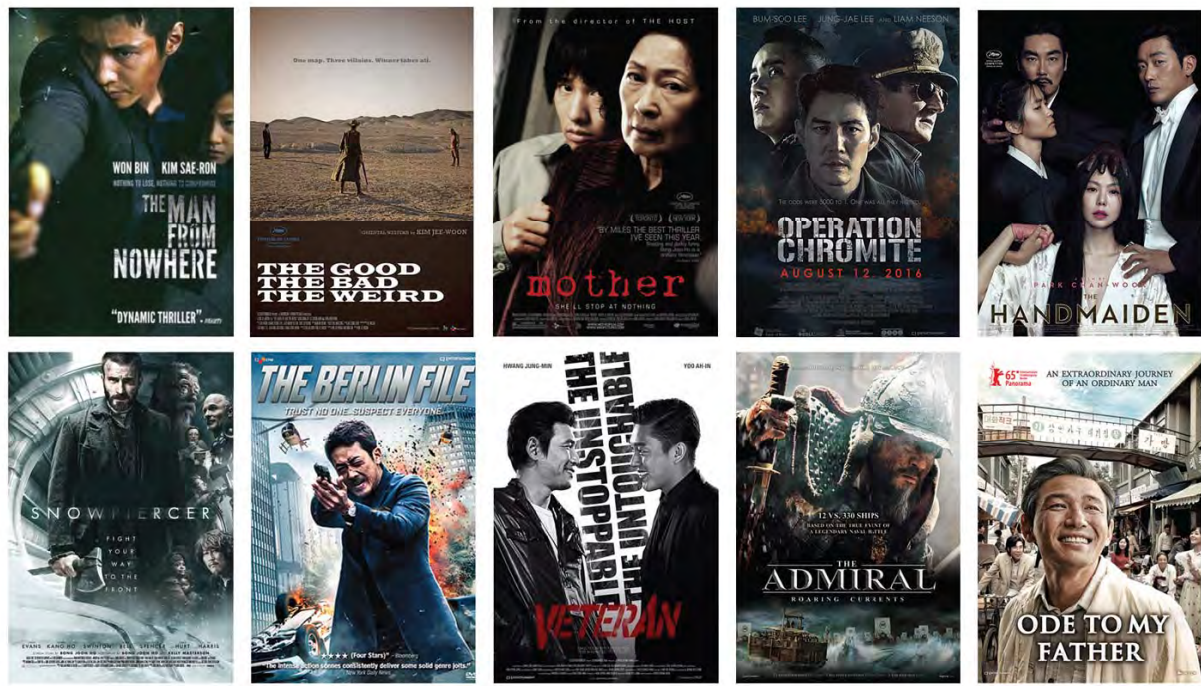
The Man from Nowhere (2010)
